COMPETITIONS:**100. Senior Team:**

A vaulting team is composed of the longer, seven (7) vaulters and one (1) vaulting horse. This competition will take place in two (2) rounds. Every team is allowed to start in the second round. The start order of both rounds will be decided by separate draws.

Entry fee: 135 Euro per Team - **Must be paid with Definite Entry.**

101. Junior Team:

A vaulting team is composed of the longer, seven (7) vaulters and one (1) vaulting horse. (The vaulters must not be or become more than 16 years old in 2011). This competition will take place in two (2) rounds. Every team is allowed to start in the second round. The start order of both rounds will be decided by separate draws.

Entry fee: 135 Euro per Team - **Must be paid with Definite Entry.**

102. Senior Individual Female:

An individual composed of the longer, one (1) vaulter, and one (1) vaulting horse. This competition will take place in two (2) rounds. Every individual vaulter is allowed to start in the second round. The start order of both rounds will be decided by separate draws.

Entry fee: 25 Euro per Vaulter - **Must be paid with Definite Entry.**

103. Senior Individual Male:

An individual composed of the longer, one (1) vaulter, and one (1) vaulting horse. This competition will take place in two (2) rounds. Every individual vaulter is allowed to start in the second round. The start order of both rounds will be decided by separate draws.

Entry fee: 25 Euro per Vaulter - **Must be paid with Definite Entry.**

104. Junior Individual Female:

An individual composed of the longer, one (1) vaulter, and one (1) vaulting horse. This competition will take place in two (2) rounds. Every individual vaulter is allowed to start in the second round. The start order of both rounds will be decided by separate draws.

Entry fee: 25 Euro per Vaulter - **Must be paid with Definite Entry.**

105. Junior Individual Male:

An individual composed of the longer, one (1) vaulter, and one (1) vaulting horse. This competition will take place in two (2) rounds. Every individual vaulter is allowed to start in the second round. The start order of both rounds will be decided by separate draws.

Entry fee: 25 Euro per Vaulter - **Must be paid with Definite Entry.**

106. Pas-de-Deux:

A Pas-de-Deux composed of the longer, two (2) vaulters, and one (1) vaulting horse. This competition will take place in two (2) rounds. Every Pas-De-Deux is allowed to start in the second round. The start order of both rounds will be decided by separate draws.

Entry fee: 50 Euro per Pas-De-Deux - **Must be paid with Definite Entry.**

GENERAL INFORMATION:**Rules:**

- The Nordic Championship follows the FEI Rules for Vaulting.
- The National Federations agreed to change some ordinary points. (These are written in this schedule)

Licence:

- All vaulters and longeurs must have an FEI licence, and these must be declared in the entry. (At the latest at Definite Entry)

Rounds:

- Every Team, Individual and/or Pas-de-Deux competes in both 1. and 2. round.

Declaration of starters:

- Declaration of starters must be announced in the Show Office at the latest 30 min. after end of Vet inspection.

Draw for the order of starting:

- Draw for the order of starting are preformed according to FEI Rules for Vaulting, Article 711.

Music.

- Must be on a CD and be handled in the Show Office at the latest at the same time as the declaration of starters.
- 1 CD per Team, Individual, Pas-de-Deux – Exception for Individual Vaulters at the same horse, going in at once.
- Please write **clearly** which music for which program/test or for which vaulter.

Start numbers – Individuals:

- Start numbers are available in Show Office against a deposit at 5 Euro / 50 DKR.

Horses:

- All horses must have received the vaccination regarding FEI Rules.
- All horses must stay in the transporter, until there passport are checked and the horses are accepted at the Showground.
- All horses must wear a number (declared by the OC) from the time where they are out of the boxes.
- There will be stable security all day/ night. The horses must not leave the showground at night.
- When the horse is mounted for riding, suitable footwear and protective headgear secured by three-point retention harness is compulsory!!!!

THE FEI CODE OF CONDUCT FOR THE WELFARE OF THE HORSE

The Federation Equestrian International (FEI) expects all those involved in international equestrian sport to adhere to the FEI's Code of Conduct and to acknowledge and accept that at all times the welfare of the horse must be paramount and must never be subordinated to competitive or commercial influences.

1. At all stages during the preparation and training of competition horses, welfare must take precedence over all other demands. This includes good horse management, training methods, farriery and tack, and transportation.
2. Horses and competitors must be fit, competent and in good health before they are allowed to compete. This encompasses medication use, surgical procedures that threaten welfare or safety, pregnancy in mares and the misuse of aids.
3. Events must not prejudice horse welfare. This involves paying careful attention to the competition areas, ground surfaces, weather conditions, stabling, site safety and fitness of the horse for onward travel after the event.
4. Every effort must be made to ensure that horses receive proper attention after they have competed and that they are treated humanely when their competition careers are over. This covers proper veterinary care, competition injuries, euthanasia and retirement.
5. The FEI urges all involved with the sport to attain the highest levels of education in their areas of expertise.

700. C - Team:

C – Teams are the same as the international junior team competition, just without any age limit.

Compulsory: Vault-on, Basic Seat, ½ mill, Swing rearways, Flag, Stand, Swing forward, Dismount swing.

Free test: Maximum of (6) six static triple exercises.

A vaulting team is composed of the longer, seven (7) vaulters and one (1) vaulting horse.

This competition will take place in two (2) rounds. Every team is allowed to start in the second round.

The start order of both rounds will be decided by the OC.

Entry fee: 135 Euro per Team - **Must be paid with Definite Entry.**

701. Individual *1 / Female:

Individual *1 / Female is the same as international individual junior competition, just without any maximum age limit.

The minimum age limit is 14 years old.

An individual is composed of the longer, one (1) vaulter, and one (1) vaulting horse.

This competition will take place in two (2) rounds. Every individual vaulter is allowed to start in the second round.

The start order of both rounds will be decided by the OC.

Entry fee: 25 Euro per Vaulter - **Must be paid with Definite Entry.**

702. Individual *1 / Male:

Individual *1 / Male is the same as international individual junior competition, just without any maximum age limit.

The minimum age limit is 14 years old.

An individual is composed of the longer, one (1) vaulter, and one (1) vaulting horse.

This competition will take place in two (2) rounds. Every individual vaulter is allowed to start in the second round.

The start order of both rounds will be decided by the OC.

Entry fee: 25 Euro per Vaulter - **Must be paid with Definite Entry.**
